## 1. OLD BUSINESS

### a. Treasurer's Report

Fallon reported that after receiving \$1600 in event proceeds, after expenses our checking account holds \$413.74.

### b. Committee Updates

Events-Eleanore and Fallon reported that the first annual Oak Grove Trolley Trail Fest was a huge success. There are plans for a Halloween Fest in coordination with Oak Grove United Methodist Church. We would like to have decorated business booths out front of the church and candy can be given out to kids. Cider and cookies inside. We can also have a canned food drive at the same time. Possible Christmas tree lighting downtown

for a winter event. Fallon will contact Pastor Heather to coordinate.

Lighting-Bobbie spoke with Wendy from Clackamas County Engineering and will set up a time in September to have Wendy and PGE walk through downtown & the Trolley Trail with the Lighting Committee to discuss lighting improvements.

Art-Sarah has begun the sign painting at The Pioneer Club (Safari Club/Cash Box) sign. She has sanded it and removed old staples and painted sample colors on it. She is posting updates on her Facebook page for community awareness. She is using her own supplies but OGHTTA will reimburse her for the paint. She will be painting both sides of the sign. October 1<sup>st</sup> is the estimated completion date.

Vinyl Tap has painted their building but according to Terry, the mural that had been planned may not happen because the landlord may not allow it.

Trolley Trail Improvements-Eleanore, Fallon and Bobbie met with Scott Archer from Parks & Rec. Scott is very excited to have a local organization to partner with to coordinate community involvement. Bobbie mentioned she was contacted by Clackamas County Engineering to get

ideas for Trolley Trail improvements. Eleanore, Fallon, Bobbie & Mike would like to be part of a Trolley Trail Improvements Committee. As a group they will work with both Parks & Rec. and the County, as well as local CPO's to develop a plan for the future of the Trolley Trail.

Historical-Mike announced that September 12<sup>th</sup>, the Oak Lodge History Detectives will be sponsoring a historic get together at Rose Villa. People in the community are encouraged to bring pictures, stories and memories of Oak Grove to share.

Membership Structure-The group decided that we should have a 7 member board for OGHTTA so that we will always have a quorum for voting. We will talk about the bylaws in the future when a committee is formed. Everyone should think about who is interested in being a board member.
